

# Lucky Foods Menu

Start the New Year right with these lucky foods.  
These foods symbolize wealth, prosperity, forward motion, and long life.

**Fresh Texas Black Eyed Pea Salad** mango, red onions, cilantro, dill, lime juice, and Serrano peppers 4/6.5  
*A southern tradition, black-eyed peas are considered auspicious based on their resemblance to coins.*

**Thai Slaws** Texas cabbage with sesame seeds, lime juice, Thai chilies, soy sauce carrots and peanut 4/6.5  
**Cabbage Soup** green onions, daikon and garlic with pork/tofu/no protein (5/8)  
*Cabbage is associated with luck and fortune because it's green and resembles money.*

**Kale Salad**- Texas curly kale with raw pecans, cranberries, sesame oil,  
**Kale Fried Rice** Dino kale, pickled cabbage, fried egg, avocado oil, brown rice, and soy sauce. Add pork belly (6.5)  
*Green is money, and who doesn't want a little more money this year?*

**Pad Mee** wheat noodles, cabbage, green onion, onions, cilantro, carrots w/ chicken (16.5), pork belly(18.5), sirloin (18.5), tofu (14.5), tempeh(16.5), or no protein(14.5).  
*Long noodles symbolize a long life, and are therefore lucky—but only if you eat them without breaking them as you pull them out of the plate. So, get your slurping technique down!*  
*Pigs are rotund, which represents prosperity. They also "root forward" with their noses, which is supposed to symbolize progress.*

**Fried Whole Fish** – preorder only. Black drum with turmeric, lemongrass, garlic, soy sauce, and ginger, served on bed of lettuce. A great sharing item for the whole table.  
*Fish are lucky in three ways: their scales resemble coins, they travel in schools, which represent prosperity, and they swim forward, symbolizing progress. (28)*

**Baked Chocolate Doughnut** (V, refined sugar free with maple syrup and coconut sugar) \$3.25 \$38/dz  
*Round food represents the year coming full circle. Their shape signifies that the old year has come to a close and the New Year holds the promise of a fresh start.*

**Lucky Coin Lemon Cake** (Dairy free, contains local eggs) by the slice \$6.95 or whole cake \$49 (whole cake is for pre-order only)  
*Find your lucky coin inside the cake! Whoever finds the coin gets a year of good luck. Be careful, don't chip that tooth.*

**Chocolate Bundt Cake** (V) Moist Chocolate Bundt cake topped with chocolate ganache and sugar sprinkles \$6.95 per slice or \$52 per whole cake (whole cake is for pre-order only)

**Vasilopita** (Dairy Free, contains eggs) Infused with the aromas and blends of oranges and garnished with a thick and glossy vanilla scented sugar glaze! Vasilopita is a traditional Greek cake or bread served at midnight on New Year's Eve to celebrate the life of Saint Basil. After baking the vasilopita cake, a coin is inserted through the base and when cut the person who finds the coin is said to be granted luck for the rest of the year! \$6.95 per slice \$52 for whole cake (whole cake is for pre-order only)

*All items are gluten free except from Pad Mee. Fried items like fried fish, fried tofu, and pork belly are fried in the same fryer as gluten containing items.*
